Overview of Moodle Reports

Moodle reports allow teachers to view course and user activity reports. Administrators can view the same reports as teachers, but can also view site logs. The displayed logs will show active links to other parts of the course, including the user's profile, a specific page in an activity, or a link to a resource.

Teacher may be able to access the Moodle reports listed on this page. Some reports only display when the features are enabled. For example, if a course does not use activity completion and course completion, then these reports will not display as options.

Competency breakdown: Teachers can view the competencies of each student along with their ratings

Course completion: Displays student progress in a course for required activities

Logs: Displays resources that are being used and when they are accessed

Live logs: Displays course logs in real time

Activity Report: Shows all activity in the course, sorted by topic

Course Participation: Provides an easy way to monitor user participation

Activity completion: Indicates completed activities with a checkmark

Statistics: When the Statistics report is enabled on a site, this report gives a quick overview graph of course views and activity levels over a certain period of time that are specified based on available filters

Event Monitoring: Create rules to manage events in a course and receive notifications
